

**Munich's Technical University makes Albert Speer an honorary professor**

Honored as TUM Distinguished Affiliated Professor for Architects

Munich's Technical University (TUM) has made Prof. Albert Speer a TUM Distinguished Affiliated Professor. The TUM alumnus is one of today's most important urban planners and architects worldwide. The TUM bestows this honorary title on renowned international scholars who are leading proponents of their respective field.

Albert Speer (77) first trained as a cabinetmaker before studying architecture at Munich's Technical College, the predecessor of the TUM. From 1972 to 1997 he taught Urban and Regional Planning at the University of Kaiserslautern. He has been visiting professor at the ETH Zürich in Switzerland. In 1964 he set up his own urban planning and architecture office in Frankfurt and today Albert Speer & Partner (AS&P) has a payroll of more than 120 staff members.

His outstanding projects include the master plans for several new cities in China, for the EXPO 2000 in Hanover, Germany, and for the Football World Cup in 2022 in Qatar. Among other things, he designed the diplomat's quarter in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia, and planned the central zone of Abuja, capital city of Nigeria. In Germany he developed the master plan for downtown Cologne and the treatise "Frankfurt for All", the strategic urban development study taking the city through to the year 2030.

Albert Speer has from the very outset taken an international approach. In 2007 AS&P founded a subsidiary in Shanghai. Speer has devoted himself to supporting scholarship, not least with the Professor Albert Speer Foundation which supports young academics in the fields of architecture and planning.
